## **Profile**

Mr. Ken Heitkamp has served as a senior executive in Air Force IT organizations including the Air Force CIO, the Air Force Standard Systems Group, and the Air Force Communication Command, and has maintained strong relationships with Air Force decisionmakers on programs including EITaaS.

Before joining Suss Consulting, Mr. Heitkamp served at the Pentagon as Associate Director in the U.S. Air Force Office of the Chief Information Officer. He directed the Air Force's information technology strategic sourcing programs that included the Information Technology Commodity Council (ITCC). He established and directed the new ITCC organization that integrated enterprise level purchasing, information technology management and program management functions under a single leadership structure. He also directed the Air Force Network Operations Center that operated critical network infrastructure for over 200 locations.
